### **Meals on Wheels Collin County to Deliver 3,000 Meals: Addressing Rising Food Costs**

On April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022, Meals on Wheels Collin County (MOWCC) will partner with volunteers to deliver additional meals to local, homebound seniors. With inflation causing food prices to rise, MOWCC aims to support seniors by sending extra meals. MOWCC clients' nutrition and health take priority for the organization, and due to the pandemic staff and volunteers continue to work around food industry supply issues.

MOWCC is calling on the community to sign up to volunteer and join the organization to deliver extra meals to senior neighbors. Approximately 100 volunteers are needed for this meal delivery. With an increasing number of local seniors joining the meal programs, MOWCC plans to deliver more meals, supplies and much-needed social interaction for local seniors than ever before.
