Collin County, TX – May 31, 2024 – Meals on Wheels Collin County (MOWCC) is taking proactive steps to ensure the well-being of our senior community. This past week, our area experienced severe storms, flash floods, and power outages. In response, we have been actively distributing survival kits and conducting wellness checks to support affected seniors.

In preparation for our office closures on Juneteenth and July 4th, we are organizing a special meal delivery event on Saturday, June 8th, at 9AM to provide over 1,700 meals to seniors. Additionally, we will have a drop-off location at our office on June 8th for anyone who wishes to donate survival kit items such as fans, flashlights, batteries, non-perishable food, bottled water, Styrofoam coolers, and first-aid supplies.
